This document is designed to complement your research on the educational and certification prerequisites for pursuing a career in Therapeutic Massage on a state-by-state basis.

<u>Educational Preparation</u>: Students completing the Associate for Therapeutic Massage program or the two certification programs (Massage Practitioner I & II) at Forsyth Technical Community College become eligible to sit for the Massage & Bodywork Licensing Examination (MBLEx) and/or obtain the National Certification Board for Therapeutic Massage and Bodywork (NCBTMB) certification. These certifications are fundamental steps in launching a career in Therapeutic Massage.

Interstate Compact for Licensed Massage Therapists: The Council of State Governments (CSG) is collaborating with the Department of Defense (DoD) and the Federation of State Massage Therapy Boards (FSMTB) to facilitate the mobility of licensed massage therapists through the development of an interstate compact. This new licensing pathway, known as the <a href="Interstate">Interstate</a> <a href="Massage Compact">Massage Compact (IMpact)</a>, aims to establish reciprocity among participating states and reduce the barriers to license portability.

IMpact enables licensed massage therapists to practice in all states that join the compact, eliminating the need to obtain individual licenses in each state of practice. Notably, on June 12, 2023, Governor Joe Lombardo signed SB161 into law, making Nevada the first state to enact the Interstate Massage Compact. To stay informed about the progress of other states joining the compact, you can visit the IMpact Map.

<u>Certification and Licensure Chart</u>: The chart that follows in this guide is applicable to those who have completed the certification program, which typically includes a minimum of 500 hours of training and have successfully passed the Massage & Bodywork Licensing Examination (MBLEx) and/or the National Certification Board for Therapeutic Massage and Bodywork (NCBTMB) certification. Additional state-specific requirements may include applications, documentation, licensing fees, liability insurance, and ongoing continuing education courses.
