



Forsyth Tech EMS Programs Advanced EMT

Information Packet

The Advanced EMT (AEMT) program offered by Forsyth Tech EMS Programs is designed to prepare students to deliver both basic and advanced emergency medical care and transportation for critically ill or injured patients who access the emergency medical system. Our AEMT program offers flexible options, with day, evening, and weekend classes available to accommodate different schedules. Courses are built to provide flexibility to meet the needs of our students.

To enroll in an AEMT course, prospective students must attend a mandatory information session (orientation) and submit all required prerequisites before the class start date. Students should follow the below steps to complete registration for an upcoming AEMT course.

Admission Requirement Steps

- **Step 1: Complete and Submit Registration Form.** Fill out the registration form and email it to Catherine Hill at chill@forsythtech.edu. If you are not affiliated with a qualifying volunteer fire department, rescue squad or EMS agency, you do not need to check any boxes in the "Affiliated Agency" section, but you MUST still sign the form.
- **Step 2: Submit FERPA Form**. Complete the FERPA form and email it to chill@forsythtech.edu. If you are claiming a fee exemption, be sure to list your affiliated department under "employer" on the FERPA form.
- **Step 3: Provide Prerequisites, Identification and proof of EMT**. Submit all required prerequisites along with a copy of a valid government-issued photo ID and valid and active NC or NR EMT certification to chill@forsythtech.edu. Students who do not currently have an EMT certification must have it completed before the start of clinical.
- **Step 4: Submit Proof of Agency Affiliation (If Applicable).** If you are affiliated with a volunteer or paid agency and wish to qualify for a fee waiver, provide an official letter of affiliation on agency letterhead, signed by your department chief.
- **Step 5: Attend the Mandatory Information Session.** Participation in the mandatory information session (orientation) is required. Failure to attend will result in ineligibility to start the class.
- **Step 6: Complete Entry Exam Requirements:** Prospective students must complete an entry examination that consists of basic EMT knowledge. The entry examination will be held during the mandatory information session (orientation). Once students submit all required prerequisite information, they will receive a study guide for the entry examination.
- **Step 6: Purchase Uniform Shirt**. Ensure that your uniform shirt is purchased by the specified deadline. Uniform shirt information and ordering procedure is discussed during the information session. Failure to order your shirt by the given timeline will prevent the student from attending the class.





Minimum Prerequisites

Students who want to enroll in an Advanced EMT course must possess a high school diploma or high school equivalent. In addition, the student must have successfully completed college-level English and math or successfully completed, within the previous 12 months, an entrance exam placing the individual into college-level English and math. Students must complete these prerequisites by the given date, which is unique for every AEMT class. Information on the placement test is available at the Testing Center located in room 133, 1st Floor, Allman Center, Main Campus, or by calling 336-734-7324. Prerequisites Check List

17 years of age on or before the official end date of the course.
High school diploma or high school equivalent.
Possession of a valid and active North Carolina EMT or NREMT Credential before the start of clinical
Successful completion of college-level English, or within the previous 12 months, complete a written
assessment placing the individual into college-level English.
Successful completion of college-level Math, or within the previous 12 months, complete a written
assessment placing the individual into college-level Math.
Must attend <i>Mandatory Orientation Session and</i> achieve the designated benchmark score on the
entry exam.
